



Day One: Sunday, June 16, 2019

Welcome to the sandy shores of Cape Cod. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. Walk along pristine beaches, revel in the arts and culture, and reclaim childhood memories of seashells, sandcastles, and saltwater taffy. Our local guide will meet us at the Blue Water Resort, where we will be staying for the next three nights, and will assist with check in. A welcome reception will be held in our honor. Dinner is included this evening.

Day Two: Monday, June 17, 2019

Breakfast is included this morning at the resort.

The local guide will meet us at the resort for a full day of touring. We will travel historic Route 6A, the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history. It winds past hundreds of historic structures which characterize its early development. View the Eastham Windmill, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and visit the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center. Sand dunes and the Atlantic Ocean surround us as we approach "Land's End", or Provincetown. At this point, we are now at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Formerly known as the "Province Lands," the pilgrims landed here first before they decided to settle across the bay in Plymouth. Take some time to enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists/fishermen village so unique.



Next, we have the choice of either a whale watching cruise or a dune tour on dry land. If you choose the cruise, you will board an excursion vessel for an amazing experience of whale watching. Travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment including birds that migrate here from all over the Atlantic and fish which use these shallow waters to feed. Try to spot Humpback, Minke, and Fin whales going about their daily business. An onboard naturalist will narrate everything you see and will answer any questions about the whales, birds, fish and lighthouses.

If you choose to stay on dry land, a dune tour will be provided. Ride along the shoreline of the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore. The guide will point out the “dune shacks” where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art.

After the excursion, we will head to dinner and then back to the hotel.

Day Three: Tuesday, June 18, 2019



Start the morning with breakfast at the hotel.

Next, the local guide will meet you at the resort and will escort us to the Hy-Line Docks for ticketing and boarding of the high-speed ferry to the island of Martha’s Vineyard. Upon arrival, we will board a local bus for a sightseeing tour, during which we will learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as we pass through Vineyard Haven. There will be free time for lunch and shopping in the historic whaling town of Edgartown. Complete the day on the island in Oak Bluffs. Be sure to stroll through “Cottage City” with its brightly painted cottages and decorative “gingerbread” trim.

Once we depart Martha’s Vineyard, we will head back to the mainland.

Tonight, we will have a delicious lobster dinner. For anyone not wanting to eat shellfish, alternative entrees will be available.



Day Four: Wednesday, June 19, 2019

Breakfast is included this morning at the hotel.

After we check out of the hotel, we will meet the local guide. The first stop of the day is at Sandwich, the oldest town on Cape Cod. There, we will see the Village Green, the Great Salt Marsh, a Cranberry Bog, and Cape Cod Bay. Sandwich became the site of one of America’s largest glass factories, an industry that flourished during the 19th century. This quaint and quiet seaside community is the hometown of Thornton Burgess, naturalist and author of 170 children’s books.

Next, we travel to America's Hometown, Plymouth. As one of the country's first settlements, it is well-known in the United States for its historical value. A quick stop will be made at the Forefather's Monument, the largest, solid granite monument in the United States. This monument stands facing the harbor, welcoming those who come by water. A stop will also be made at the Plymouth Rock, the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims in 1620.



Lunch and shopping are on your own.

Once we finish our time in Plymouth, we will bid farewell to the local guide. We will then depart for home with sand in our shoes, seashells in our pocket and many fond memories of Cape Cod!
